

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE OF CITY OF RICHMOND, KANSAS, 2013, SECTION 15-207, CONNECTION FEES, AND SECTION 15-403, PERMIT; CONNECTION FEE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Richmond, Kansas:

Section 1. Section 15-207 of the code of the City of Richmond is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-207. CONNECTION FEES. The fees for connection to the city waterworks system shall be as follows:

(a) For connecting water main with three-fourths inch tap, three-fourths inch service line and installing three-fourths inch meter, a non-refundable fee of \$1,000.00 plus tax;

(b) For connecting water main with larger than a three-fourths inch tap, service line or meter, a non-refundable fee to be determined by the governing body at the time of such request.


Section 2. Section 15-403 of the code of the City of Richmond is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-403. PERMIT; CONNECTION FEE. (a) no person shall uncover, make any connections with or opening into, use, alter, or disturb any public sewer or appurtenances thereof without first obtaining a written permit from the city.

(b) There shall be charged a non-refundable fee of \$750.00 payable at the time of making application for the permit.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
