

Special City Council Meeting
April 11, 2013

A. Call to Order: The Special Meeting of the Richmond City Council was called to order by Mayor Shelden Snow.

Council Members Present: Mary Ann Platt, Rick Weber and Mary Harris. Verlin Springer and Claire Blackburn were absent from the meeting.

Staff present: Jake Strobel and Marla Gadelman.

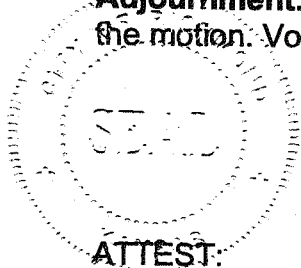
Guests Present: Betty Bowlby, Doug McIntosh, Helen Feuerborn, Donna Thompson and Connie Weber.

ITEMS OF BUSINESS:

1. Purchase of Dump Truck. There were concerns about the dump truck once it was examined closer. The exhaust system was towards the end of its life, there was a leak in the rear end and other small things for the dealer to look at. The speedometer and tachometer quit working as Jake was taking the truck back to the dealer. To make repairs the price of the dump truck will increase. The motion was passed to purchase the truck, but new information has come up and the council may consider rescinding the motion. After discussion Mary Harris made a motion to rescind the previous motion to purchase the dump truck. Mary Ann Platt seconded the motion. Vote 3-0, motion passed.

2. Consideration of payment for attendance at Governing Body Institute and Mayor's Conference on May 10 and 11, 2013, for council members and incoming council members. The Institute is put on by the League of Kansas Municipalities. The cost for attending the Governing Body Institute is \$160.00 per person. Sessions include Home Rule, Kansas Open Meetings Act, Ordinances and Voting, Municipal Finance, and Personnel Management. The new Governing Body Handbooks will be available following the conference. Two copies are given to the City and additional copies may be purchased for \$25.00 each. After discussion Mary Ann Platt made a motion to pay for conference fees for council members, sitting or inbound, to attend the LKM Governing Body Institute. Mary Harris seconded the motion. Vote 2-1, motion carried.

Adjournment: Mary Ann Platt made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mary Harris seconded the motion. Vote 3-0, motion passed. 7:54 PM
