

Special City Council Meeting

A. Call to Order: The Special Meeting of the Richmond City Council was called to order by Mayor Snow for the limited purposes set forth on the Call for Special City Council Meeting signed by all council members.

Council Members Present: Karen Peters, Helen Feuerborn, Michael LaRose, Verlin Springer and Doug McIntosh.

Guests Present: None


Review tractor repair bids and authorize repairs. Bids from Heartland Tractor in the amount of \$750 and McConnell Machinery Co., Inc. in the amount of \$1,872.63 were provided to the council. Doyle believes that the bid from McConnell Machinery may cover any other parts that are not included in the "package" which they believe may be necessary to repair the tractor. The bid from Heartland Tractor only covers the "package". After thorough discussion, Doug McIntosh made a motion to accept the bid from Heartland Tractor in the amount of \$750.00, and to further authorize Doyle Sobba to use his discretion to allow Heartland Tractor to complete the repairs to the PTO at any cost in addition to the \$750.00 bid. Verlin Springer seconded the motion. Vote 5-0, motion passed.

Pickup and delivery of the tractor to Heartland Tractor was also discussed. After discussion Verlin Springer made a motion to allow Doyle Sobba to use his discretion, after obtaining the costs of pickup and delivery from Heartland Tractor, whether to accept their charges or to use his personal trailer and truck to deliver the tractor, and be reimbursed at half the rate charged by Heartland Tractor. Doug McIntosh seconded the motion. Vote 5-0, motion passed.

Review backhoe repair and bid and authorize repairs. A bid from Coleman Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$5,422.85 was provided to council. Staff is not aware of any other companies that work on this type of equipment. Other vendors can provide oil filters and such other items, but will not do the actual repairs. After thorough discussion, Doug McIntosh made a motion to accept the bid from Coleman Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$5,422.85 to repair the backhoe. Verlin Springer seconded the motion. Vote 5-0, motion passed.

Doug McIntosh made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Verlin Springer seconded the motion. Vote 5-0, motion passed. Time: 7:35 PM.
