A. Call to Order: The Regular Meeting of the Richmond City Council was called to order by Mayor Sheldon S. Snow.

C. Consent Agenda:

Approval of Minutes of Meetings and Expenses: Doug McIntosh made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 11, 2016, meeting as written, and to approve the expenses since the October 11, 2016 meeting with the additional approval of a bill from Leroy Kratzberg for \$140.92 for the repair of the back door of City Hall and the Library.
